## Dates for prayer/information

- 1 *Easter* Please pray for all Easter services in our chaplaincies.  
**Knokke** holds its AGM at 6 pm at St. Georges.  
**Frauenkirche, Dresden:** Easter Day Family Eucharist at 4 pm. We believe it will be the first time that an Easter Day Anglican Communion Service will have taken place in Dresden since sometime before the beginning of WW2!
- 8 **HT Corfu** Easter services. *Greek Easter:* This is an amazing wonderful whole week celebration where people come from all over Greece and the world and the small kids stay up for the *Anastasi* (Resurrection) at midnight. May all who come, be touched by the truth of the reason of celebration.
- 10 There will be four separate summer **seasonal** prep days. Pray for the **Cavallino** team, meeting with Jim Perryman in London this lunchtime. As the winter season ends in Wengen today, so give thanks for the chaplains who have served here over the past seventeen weeks, remembering those residents who now patiently wait for the church to reopen at the end of May. Pray too for Frances Houghton as she arrives in **Zermatt** for the final fortnight of the winter season there (10-24).
- 12 The **Interlaken** summer chaplains meet near Warwick for their preparation day. May this be a useful time together with good plans made for the summer outreach. Some will be 'virtually' present through Skype, pray for the technology to work well.
- 13 **HT Corfu South:** Communion Service at Messonghi, thanks for the use of the Catholic Church.
- 17 Interview for a new Chaplain for **St. Mark's, Versailles**.
- 19 **Wengen and Zermatt** summer seasonal chaplains meet in Kenilworth for their preparation day. The team includes some 'first-timers' and others returning to seasonal chaplaincy after some years. Pray that the interaction between experienced, less-experienced and new chaplains will be beneficial to all in their mission and ministry this summer and that the Spirit will guide us to new opportunities.  
**St. James, Voorschoten** annual meeting is taking place. We give thanks for God's blessing and provision this last year, and seek His guidance and provision for the coming twelve months, including the need for someone new to stand for churchwarden.

- 29 **HT Corfu:** AGM, we pray for a good attendance and hearts to respond to the call of service on PCC.

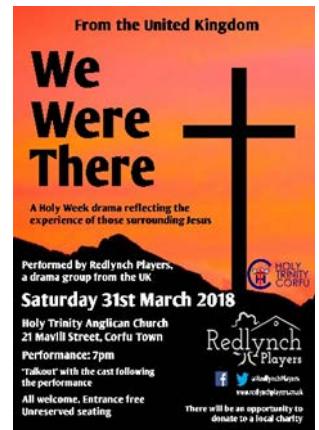

## ICS Family News



**Dennis Sadler**, our long-standing Council Member, Seasonal Chaplain, Vice Patron and friend died on 6 March at the age of eighty-three. He had been unwell for some time. Jim Perryman (ICS Seasonal Mission Manager) writes about Dennis's involvement in ICS. *'How can I briefly honour our dear friend, Dennis Sadler? I struggle with 'brief' and there is so much to say. Supporter, Seasonal Chaplain, Council Member, Vice-Patron—all of these speak of Dennis's deep commitment to ICS over so many years, but none of them really get close to properly describing the man and his dedication. A man of passion and compassion; a man of integrity who lived out, in so many aspects of life, the fulness of his profession. His wisdom and careful choice of words—and when to speak—particularly experienced through the years we were on ICS Council together, are things that the rest of us could do well to emulate. As chair of the Seasonal Mission Support Group, his heart for the work and his support of successive Seasonal Mission Managers (first Trevor Letchford and then myself) enabled so much to be achieved. Dennis, always fully in partnership with Elizabeth, undertook many summer chaplaincies in France building good relationships with the locals and enhancing the reputation of ICS. For many years, they produced all the publicity for the seasonal mission, ensuring that there was quality and consistency. Alongside this, the 'ICS News and Prayer Diary' also came under their skilful care. Dennis also supported many of the permanent chaplaincies, often leading groups to visit and encourage the chaplains and their congregations. With his passing, we have lost a depository of a wealth of knowledge about the Society, and a great personal friend of many. We entrust him with absolute confidence into the eternal loving care of the God he has so faithfully served, and enfold Elizabeth with our love and prayer in her great loss in this world.'*
